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## **CLOTH TO CLOTHING: SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES IN DESIGN AND MAKING**

### **PLEASE BRING**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

### **MATERIAL LIST**

- Diary/sheets of paper for drawing and notes
- Drawing tools of choice including a fine tip marker, HB pencil and eraser
- Sheets or roll of recycled medium weight paper that will provide a surface area of approximately 4x1 meters. Paper examples - the equivalent of a light weight litho/drawing paper or brown paper, rolls of old wrapping paper with white backing. Butchers paper can be used however is a bit fragile and tears easily. If you have a lightweight garment interfacing material this can also be used.
- Tape measure and straight ruler
- Sticky tape and glue stick
- Sewing pins
- Scissors for paper and fabric
- Used medium weight fabric for testing/toiling patterns (example old sheets or tablecloth)
- Sewing machine
