ECOPRINTING ON LEATHER

PLEASE BRING

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

MATERIAL LIST

- Minimum of 2 rollers, can be wood or metal, no longer than 35 cms, about as thick as a broomstick. If you can bring more rollers, please do so.
- Leaves and other botanicals.
- Biggest dye pot you can bring, if you can't bring one, some will be available on site.
- Plastic painters drop sheet
- String
- Apron
- Waterproof texta
- 2 plastic buckets
- Gloves
- You might like to bring some protein fabric or some papers to print on at the beginning of class while we wait for the leather to be mordanted.

Materials Fee: \$60 to be paid in cash on the first day of the workshop.

In this course students will work with several types of leather. While students are encouraged to bring their own leather if they want, a pack of different leathers will be supplied with the material fee. The pack will contain at four types of skins, chosen on the basis of their suitability for printing.
