## **STITCHING FEELING AND MEMORY INTO CLOTH – TRACING YOUR LIFE PATTERN ACROSS TIME**

**TUTOR: JOY DENISE SCOTT**

### **PLEASE BRING**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Water bottle

### **MATERIAL LIST**

- Notebook and pen
- Threads - Choose one colour tone that you closely identify with – bring a selection of threads in different shades/tints/hues of selected colour and in different thicknesses. Make sure to bring some pearlized threads silk or cotton size #8 and #5.
- Also choose one or two different coloured threads for couching and contrast work.
- Sue Spargo Gold Eye Milliner needle #15 (this is a special needle for gimp and other thicker threads).
- Basic sewing kit with an assortment of needles according to your thread choices (note for wrapping stitches such as French and bullion knots choose milliner, straw or long fine needles.
- 1 piece of lightweight cotton, silk, or any natural fibre fabric for developing a stitch glossary (new or repurposed is fine – 30cm x 40cm)
- Embroidery and dress making scissors
- Dress making pins (long fine ones preferable)
- 20cm diameter embroidery hoop (optional)
- 2-3 sheets of A3 drawing paper and a set of colouring pencils

### **Optional**

- Discarded soft light/loose open weave fabric within your colour tone – (the more deteriorated the better)

**Material fee** \$30 per student to be in cash for the tutor on the first day.

Includes:

2 x 30 x 40 cm lengths of silk organza/habotai

Assorted fragments of silk and scrim and other light weight materials

Pieces of gimp, silk whisper, mulberry bark and assorted fibres for couching
