## REALIST WILDLIFE

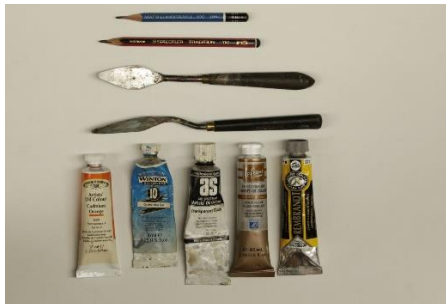

### Materials list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your work table
- Full set of oils or acrylics:

Titanium white, lamp black, transparent black, burnt and raw umber, burnt and raw sienna, ultramarine, cobalt, Manganese and tasman blue, alizarin crimson, cad yellow, cad red, yellow ochre, sap green.

- Turpentine
- Rags
- Mal sticks (see photo)
- Palette knife
- Bristle brushes (mostly filbert and square tip)
- Fine detail brushes (taklon)
- Bakers Wrap roll (from supermarket)
- Clean, Empty jars x 3 with lids (something like pasta sauce jars)
- Pencils and any variety of canvas small, medium
- Fixative and varnish spay can.
- Canvases: bring whichever you currently use but Brett's preferred surfaces are:
  1. Canvas on board (an archival quality board through Harrison's art supplies, Mitcham)
  2. Gesso on MDF (make sure at least 3 coats)
  3. Stretched canvasone major canvas/board for their workshop piece and 2 or 3 smaller ones for studies and painting exercise.
