Student requirement list

- **Name tag**
- **Coffee mug**
- Apron
- Band aids
- Pens, pencils and sketchbook
- A fine sharpie
- Tweezers
- Scissors
- ruler
- Plastic contact sheet – used to cover school books
- Scalpels or box cutters
- Cutting mat
- Masking tape
- Any pliers you may have, flat and round nose.
- A pair of side cutters
- Piercing saw
- A selection of sawblades, particularly 5/0 and 4/0
- 2 x half round hand files; one for aluminium, one for other metals and plastics
- 2 x Half round needle files; one for aluminium, one for other metals and plastics
- Drill bits – bring a selection
- Bags to take your work and extra material purchased home
- Any jewellery findings you may have in your stash (earring hooks, jump rings, stud and brooch backs, clasps, etc)
- Different sorts of plastic sheet to experiment on: Perspex (coloured and clear), polypropylene sheet, old yogurt containers, etc.
- If you have a laptop computer with a photo editing software (e.g. Photoshop), please bring it with you. This is not a necessity, but it reduces the time pressure on the tutor's computer.

Materials

Materials fee \$60

This materials fee covers the cost of sublimation paper and inks and students will be provided with a selection of metal blanks that we will put images on to. Extra materials and jewellery findings will be available to purchase.

The tutor will provide you with printed sheets with a variety of images for you to choose from. You will also be able to print your own images. If you think you will want to do this, please start collecting images you might want to print, e.g. personal photos, old advertising prints, drawings, paintings, abstract patterns, etc. The possibilities are limited only by your imagination. Think colour!

Bring the images as electronic files on a thumb drive, the higher the resolution of the image, the better.

Students will be required to wear covered shoes at all times.
