SCARVES: INTEGRATING FELT!

Materials list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- 1x sheet of plastic to cover the tabletop.
- Bubble wrap (small bubbles) approx 2 pieces each 2 and 3 metres lengths for the (use for rolling the felt)
- 1litre plastic drinks container with plastic lid with small holes punched in it or felting bulbs for wetting fibre down.
- Plastic container for water eg ice cream container
- Terylene / nylon loose woven curtain fabric (to place over work when wetting down the fibres) approx. 1.50 / 2 metres (can often be found in op shops & spotlight)
- 2x old towels
- Approx 1metre length of PVC tubing from 2cm to 5cm diameter or dowel wood eg broom handle width (used for rolling the felt)
- 6 x lengths of elastic approx. 30cm to tie up bubble wrap for rolling.
- Pure Soaps such as olive oil or sunlight soap
- Finest painters plastic drop sheet
- Wool fibre merino tops around 22microns at least 500gms in assorted colours of your choice.
- Recycled silk, synthetic scarves, which you no longer use or op shop scarves. These may have fringes hanging from the edges or just stitched edges.
- Scarf lengths of Georgette silk plain white or dyed to match your fibre colour scheme. Pieces of muslin, light-weight synthetic fabrics with an open weave so the wool fibre will pass through the fabric.
- Embellishments such as, yarns, knitting wools, silk pieces, needles, embroidery threads, beads for stitching into the wool, scissors, tape measure, pens, note book, assorted felting tools.
