Student requirement list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Sewing machine with a new needle and spares. Extension cord and bower board
- Darning foot/quilting foot for free motion sewing
- Assorted threads, no need to match specific colours unless that is important to you. Black is a good general colour.
- Assorted fabrics. Small pieces only are needed. Anything that will relate to the theme of insects and wings. Can be unusual fabrics, laces, glitz, shiny stuff, whatever you want to experiment with.
- Assorted bits, pom poms, jewels, sequins, buttons, pipe cleaners, etc
- Glue, strong glue such as Tiger glue (from Spotlight) or Aquadhere.
- Wire, if you have it.

The substrates

Bring things you already have, such as

- Acetate sheets
- watercolour papers
- Tulle, a metre total will be plenty

- Jan will bring a collection of strange things to add to the mix and will also bring something of everything, so if you don't have an item don't stress, she can supply/share it.
