WILD ABOUT FLORA

Material list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your worktable
- Medium piece of bubble wrap approx 800mmx1m. Plus smaller pieces of bubble.
- Thin plastic sheet x 2 same size as bubble plus smaller pieces of plastic.
- 200g merino wool tops. 18/19 micron. Varying colours to suit your project, plus some black and white. (This is more than you will need but it gives you choice.) Some coarser fibres such as Corriedale if you want something really structural for your neckpiece. If you have some short fibre merino batts bring them too they are great for jewellery. Kraftkolour has some. Specify you want the 19 micron.
- Bar of Soap (essential),
- Small ice cream container 2 litre,
- Ball brause if you have one.
- Selection of fibres to add in i.e silk top, mohair, silk hankies, spun wool, silk fabric, muslin etc. Bring a good assortment.
- Small flicker or scratching tool.
- Small found objects for trapping eg stones, large glass beads, wood. Only if your project requires it.
- Objects that can be used as a mold to help create a form. (They need to have a simple shape that can be freed with only the flexibility of the wool and one or 2 cuts. Not too much undercut). These cannot be too big. Think about what size you would like to have hanging around a neck. The idea is to possibly make multiples.
- A couple of old towels
- Paper, pencils and ideas, inspiration, camera
- Really strong thread / needles. (may want a curved one also)
- Matching cotton or wool threads for any stitching required
- Embroidery threads
- Snips, and jewellery wire (depends on your design)
- Sharp scissors with a point

- Felting needles (optional)
- Felting mat, small tools to get into small spaces to help felting. (optional)
- Table risers for 1 table
