FELTED VESSELS

Material list

- **Name tag**
- **Coffee mug**
- 500g short fibre, strong wool tops or carded batts (not needled pre-felt). This should be 22micron – 30micron and can be Merino, Corriedale, Finn or blends of these. Various colours of your choice. Fibre Arts Shed (previously Feltfine) have a good range Finn wool in natural colours as well as dyed Corriedale. Clare, has offered to take orders for pick up at Halls Gap. - Containers/vases or the like to use as a mould for your vessels. These need to be removed so no handles, or concave shapes.
- Tape measure & ruler
- Calculator, notebook & pen/pencil and a felt-tip marker pen
- Sharp scissors (large and small if you have them)
- A variety of light-weight open weave fabric such as tissue silk, paj silk or cotton gauze, yarns, other fibres such as silk tops, silk hankie, soy, flax, etc (optional and only small amounts needed)
- bubble wrap approx 1m x 1m & another piece 1m x 50cm
- Pure liquid soap concentrate (grated olive oil soap dissolved in hot water is ideal) and sprinkling bottle (1 litre plastic milk bottle with very small holes drilled in the lid works well)
- Cake of pure soap (essential)
- One small piece of nylon netting approx .5m x 1m
- Three old towels
- Bucket & Rubber gloves
