Student requirement list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- plastic to cover your work table
- 500g wool tops or carded batts, and should be 25micron – 30micron. Various colours of your choice, though natural colours work best. Bennett and Gregor www.bennettandgregor.com have a good choice of natural coloured wool tops and Feltfine www.feltfine.com.au have a good range of carded Finn batts.
- Containers/vases or the like to use as a mould for your vessels. These need to be removed so no handles, or concave shapes. (Pam will have some available to use as well)
- Tape measure & ruler
- Calculator
- Note book & pen
- Texta pen
- Sharp scissors (large and small if you have them)
- A variety of light-weight fabric scraps, yarns, other fibres such as silk, silk hankie, soy, flax, etc (optional and only a small amount needed)
- Some found objects to attach for embellishments, e.g. rusted washers, pebbles (optional)
- bubble wrap approx 1m x 1m & another piece 1m x 50cm
- Pure liquid soap concentrate (grated olive oil soap dissolved in hot water is ideal) and sprinkling bottle (1 litre plastic milk bottle with very small holes drilled in the lid works well)
- Cake of pure soap
- One small piece of nylon netting approx .5m x 1m
- Three old towels
- 3 plastic shopping bags
- Bucket & Rubber gloves
- A clothes airer if you are travelling by car and can bring one to share amongst the class.
