Material list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your work table
- 1 goat or lamb skin if you have them
- Plastic painters drop sheet
- String
- Waterproof texta
- 2 rollers, can be wood or metal, no longer than 35 cms, about as thick as a broomstick
- 1 litre of vinegar
- 20 grams soda ash
- 20 grams of aluminum sulphate
- Leaves and other botanicals
- Plastic bucket
- Biggest dye pot you can bring, if you can't bring one, some will be available on site.
(If you are able to bring a dye pot suitable for induction and portable induction cook top preferred)

Materials fee: \$60 payable in cash on the first day of the workshop (this will cover dyes, mordants and four different types of leather).
