SCRAPPY BAGS

Student requirement list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- The equivalent of at least a metre of mixed fabrics. These can be furnishing fabrics, patchwork fabrics, old clothing, etc.
- Scraps of lace, sari ribbons, doilies, knitted jersey scraps, felt, these are for adding decoration.
- About a metre of fabric for lining. This can be plain or patterned, something that tones in with your fabrics.
- At least half a metre of thin wadding, cotton or synthetic.
- Sewing machine (extension cord and power board). Your bag can be made by hand but will take much longer.
- Machine sewing threads in colours to match your fabrics and spare needles for your machine
- Fabric scissors
- Ruler
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter (optional)
- Tape measure
- Pins
- Sewing needles
- Embroidery threads, buttons, beads, broken jewellery, anything for decoration.
- One or two magnetic bag closures, the ones that you sew in by hand when the bag's finished are the easiest, but if you have the other type I will show you how to use them (the ones that have the split pin style back)
