Material list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Thimble – plastic/rubber or similar
- Small sharp pointed scissors
- Parallel pliers – non serrated faces. For example - <https://koodak.com.au/products/flat-nose-pliers?variant=30156430605> or <https://koodak.com.au/products/nylon-jaw-pliers>
- Needles – tapestry and chenille needles in various sizes and a handful of general domestic sewing needles in various sizes. Bring tapestry and chenille needles in larger sizes. For example bring chenille needles in sizes 18, 20, 22 and 24 and or tapestry needles in sizes 18, 20, 22. Bring any other big eyed needles you may have on hand. Bring a few of each (3 or more) as you may be working with more than one needle at a time.
- Cutting mat
- Small steel ruler
- A selection of cords, fibres/threads in various gauges from your stash. For more rigid cords no thicker than approx 1 or 1.2mm thicknesses. Any materials are fine eg - linen, silk, hemp, jute, balls of wool, cotton, acrylic etc. Bring in colours you want to work with.
- Notebook and pen
- Permanent marker – black, medium/fine
- Please bring magnifier glasses or headband magnifiers or a loop if you have them as we will be wrangling many threads and this is fine work

- **Material fee of \$40 to be paid in cash to the tutor on the first day of the workshop.**
