Student requirement list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Skin tones stranded cotton such as (DMC) 422; 407; 3863; 3859; 3862; 3864; 3863; 950; 95; 754; 738. I tend to use DMC because it had a slight sheen. 06,07 and 08. 'Ecru' is good for highlight. However, this is a little racist as it assumes light white skin. Hair tones of your choice, as well as any incidental clothing or background colours. I will bring my stash as well.
- White sewing thread
- A piece of 30 x 30 cm linen or cotton. I tend to use an off-white colour or you may like to try black for drama of a night time image.
- Scissors, embroidery needles (I tend to use milliners needles), 3 cm safety pins (around 4-6)
- We will use a number of ways to transfer images. Sometimes you need different methods depending on image and base cloth.
- Frixion pen (often used for sudoku puzzles apparently as they evaporate with heat) for transferring image onto base cloth
- An image of a face no more than 10 cms diameter, smaller is good. Preferably a black and white photocopied image (as well as the original if possible). I will supply tracing paper and water soluble fabric (this can be used as a tracing medium then washed away)
- I will bring my iPad with apps that allow you to 'posterise' your image. This simplifies the image breaking it up into flat areas of colour.
