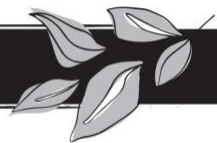

MATERIAL LIST

Brushes

- One Bamboo Goat Hair Sumi-e brush,
- Brush size approximately 260 mm in total length, head width 8- 10 mm.
- If you have a number of brushes, please bring them and we will select one to use. I always have spare brushes, but most art shops have a basic brush.

Other

- Two white Soy sauce dishes.
- A water container or bowl.
- A paper weight (rock will be fine).
- An old tea towel or nappy.
- A white bread and butter plate (Op shop).
- A sketch book and drawing implements.
- I will supply papers, ink and felts for painting supports, however, students are welcome to bring any ink sticks, ink stones, etc. that they may have.
- I have looked at Seniors Art supplies and would recommend purchasing a couple of sheets of Awagami Hoshō paper for final works.

Material fee \$10 to be paid to the tutor on the first day of your workshop.
