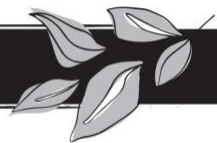

- Name tag

- Water bottle

MATERIAL LIST

- **Acrylic paints** (Golden heavy body recommended or your preferred brand)
 - Hansa Yellow Light
 - Pthalo Blue (green shade)
 - Quinacridone Magenta (or Primary Magenta)
 - Cadmium Orange (or Pyrrole Orange)
 - Dioxazine Purple
 - Permanent Green Light
 - Titanium White
- Plastic palette knives
- **Brushes:** Neef or similar Short Flat Taklon 5mm, 10mm and 25mm (on the Seniors web site you will find them under “watercolour & gouache brushes” in synthetic/flat.)
- Easy clean palette (not wood) or tear-off palette book
- Sketchbook with watercolour paper or canvas pages
- Masking tape
- 2 x 10 or 12 inch square canvases. Size is less important than that they are square.
- Sketching easel or table easel
- Water container
- Kitchen paper
- Landscape photographs to use for subject matter. These are best printed on paper at photo quality if possible.
