- Some stencils if you have them (Tutor will have some too) We will also make some of our own stencils
- Acrylic paints White, black, yellow, red, blue, fluro pink and paynes grey as a bare minimum. Bring what you love and what you have!
- Acrylic brushes of various widths and shapes (some small some medium and some larger)
- Graphite pencil or 8B lead pencil
- Oil pastels. Recommend at least one Senellier in a grey, white or cream
- A stack of vintage or decorative collage papers
- Blade/exacto knife
- A roll of paper towel and rags.
- A medium size dish for water
- Cream Posca pen. Other paint markers and poscas if you have them.
- 2 to 3 medium size cradled wood boards approx 45 x30cm
