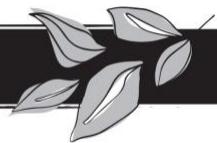

COLOUR 101 PASTELS

PLEASE BRING

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

MATERIAL LIST

Pastels – bring whatever you have. A set of 60 would be the minimum required. Some key colours are found in my basic box of unison pastels or the understanding colour set: See below images.

You can see my sets on my website [CLICK HERE](#). If you have no pastels and want to hire a set from me for \$15 per day just let me know and I will reserve a set for you.

Paper: Art Spectrum colourfix original Storm Blue – 2 x A3 size (or a full sheet cut in half)

Terracotta – 1 x A3 size (or a half sheet) Soft umber – 1 x A3 size. (or half sheet)

- Willow Charcoal
- Paper Towel
- old brush to remove pastel.
- Backing Board: well-padded and bigger than your paper with Bull Dog clips.
- Easel: standing or table.
- Drop sheet.
- Kneadable eraser.
- Apron – optional

Reference material: Bring your own reference of a landscape that has distance to try to capture. I will supply the reference for practice ones.
