CREATING UNIQUE SURFACES FOR DRY MEDIA

PLEASE BRING

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

MATERIAL LIST

- Pigmented inks in one or two colours of your choosing, plus sepia ink.
- Small jars or containers with lids in which to mix custom colours of the inks
- Acid-free white tissue paper – several sheets
- Soft 1 or 2-inch flat brush, a small round brush, and a cheap hake brush
- A container for water to clean brushes
- Spray bottle for water and a squirter bottle (OPTIONAL)
- Paper towels
- White plastic garbage bags. It is essential to have white; a coloured plastic bag is unsuitable – a dozen
- Scissors, a small plastic spoon, and a palette knife
- Acrylic paint (not interactive)- black and white plus your choice of one other colour
- Small containers for mixing the paints
- Suitable rigid surface such as a plastic palette or tray to roll paint on, approx. A4
- Small sponge roller (approx 7 cm) and a container in which to wash the roller
- Clear pastel primer. I strongly recommend Art Spectrum Brand. It is available in 3 grades – Smooth, Original, and Supertooth. I will be using Supertooth, but note that any of these are suitable
- Small sponge to apply pastel primer to pastel paper
- Binder medium
- Self-adhesive 2mm foam sheets, any colour. Available in craft stores and dollar shops in A4 and A5 sizes in packs of 12. These will be cut into small shapes so ensure your scissors will cut out small shapes easily
- An old CD disc
- 2 x A4 foamboard (Officeworks)
- Craft knife and metal ruler
- Pastel paper of your choice, in a white or light colour, that will take wet media such as Art Spectrum Colourfix – 2 full sheets, which we will cut into various sizes. These can be safely cut in half for ease of packing.
