- 1 x Clear acrylic sheet, A3, 3-5mm thick <https://amzn.to/4kFGse>
- Thick Cardboard A3 (to act as a backing board to acrylic sheets)
- 4 x Bull-dog Clips
- 1-2x Calico Tote bag (washed) <https://amzn.to/3LP2yII>
- Measuring jug, 1L <https://amzn.to/45H5nfc>
- 1x Solid black press stud wallet folder <https://tinyurl.com/bdb425fc>
- Amber or black plastic bottle 500ml - 1L <https://amzn.to/3MkRTzf>

Please keep in mind that if the student wants to make more prints, it would be best to get another set of clear acrylic sheets plus board plus bulldog clips. I suggest that everyone has two. This way, they have one processing and another one being worked on.
