PLEASE BRING

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

EQUIPMENT:

- Sewing machine – must be able to disengage the feed-dogs
- Darning/embroidery foot + universal foot.
- Extension table
- Pack of jeans/denim needles
- Sharp scissors (both large and small if possible)
- Usual sewing paraphernalia (tape measure, pins, etc.)
- Red and blue fine-liner, felt-tipped pen.

MATERIALS:

- ½ metre cotton duck canvas (between 400gsm and 250gsm – like that used by artists on which to paint)
- 1 metre cotton type fabric for backing (relevant to image chosen – this needs to be auditioned once the postcard is completed so access to a quilting shop is always a bonus)
- Small set of *Inktense* medium (to colour the background). One set per class is more than adequate as a little goes a long way. This water-based medium comes in coloured pencils, blocks and crayons.
- Cheap bristle brushes in various sizes (to colour the background). These can also be shared.
- A collection of off cuts of fabric; all types excepting stretch fabrics. See through netting/tulle, organza's, silks etc. are very useful. A communal bag of odds and ends that everybody can both add to and dip into is very useful.
- A variety of different coloured sewing threads (not embroidery). Students are always happy to share as only small amounts of different colours are used.
- Sewing machine oil.
- Extra bobbins.
