## COLLAGE - THE COAST

### Materials list

- Plastic to cover your table, Coffee mug and name tag
- 2 stretched canvases. 50 x 40 cm recommended.
- 1 heavy card or watercolour paper (76 x 50cm approx.) Cut in half.
- Acrylic paints. I recommend Atelier or Matisse in 75 ml tubes. Preferably do not use student quality paint. You will need a range of colours – red, yellow, blue, white, an earth (ochre or umber) and some of your favourites.
- Photos of your favourite coastlines. I will have plenty there, so don't worry if you haven't any.
- PVA. 500ml
- 1 wide pastry style brush. (3cm)
- A range of brushes in various sizes.
- A jar with a lid.
- A drawing pencil and eraser.
- An old shirt or apron/ smock.
- A roll of masking tape.
- A sharp knife (e.g. a Stanley knife).
