If anyone has a portable press please bring it along.

- Apron and disposable gloves – blue nitrile best
- Ideas for images
- Etching needle for drypoint
- A medium size felt tip pen – for preparing stencils
- Printmaking paper including some black paper for the stencil, 300gsm best
- Pencils brushes, pens drawing paper

Materials fee \$25 to be paid in cash to the tutors on the first day of the workshop

Includes: Notes, transparent acrylic sheets, 1 sheet of black 300gsm paper, inks, acrylic paints, brushes, sponges and numerous other miscellaneous items
