## THE ART OF CAPTURING MEMORIES

Tutor: Catherine Hamilton

### Materials list

- Coffee mug and Name tag
- This workshop will include the use of using pencil/ink/drawing pens and charcoal to use for sketching. You may choose any of your favoured medium to use and I will be giving you plenty of demonstrations on fun and quick ways to record your favourite subjects.

- Set of good quality sketching pencils B -6B

Pack of mixed charcoal.

Good quality eraser and/ or putty eraser

Bottle of black Quink ink (available at office works) or black drawing ink. I will be using both to show you.

Brushes for colour work. I find the refill water reservoir brushes useful

Soft brushes/dip pens to use with the ink

Pipette for ink use

Small palette

spray bottle

Fine liner permanent ink drawings pens I use UNI pens in various sizes.

Water container for use when outside or in the studio

Small board to lean on when outside

Small stool ( optional) for working outside hat/sunscreen/waterbottle/carrybag

Paper towel/soft rags

**Options for colour work I will include line and wash in the demonstrations using water colour, including the use of inks and other various media.**

**You can include any media that you enjoy using for your colour work in the sketchbooks and I will bring a variety to demonstrate. You do not need to provide all of these!**

Watercolour travel set for washing in colour or tubes of watercolour

Gouache paints/set

Texta pens

Watercolour pencils

Inktense pencils

Pure pigment blocks such as Art Graf

Pastel pencils

Other medium of your choice

**FOR YOUR SKETCHBOOK.**

**I will provide one sheet of watercolour paper (additional sheets available at approx \$10 per sheet) and the foam core board for the cover of your sketchbook. You may have the option of purchasing these materials from me at an extra cost of \$15. Payment is made directly to me on the day.**

**OR**

2 sheets of good quality watercolour paper. (I use Arches or Baohong 300gsm watercolour paper, medium) You will need one sheet per book.

Sticky back foam core board available at officeworks or your art shop

Ruler/set square

Scissors

Thin (approx. 1 cm) masking tape ( plain not coloured)

Cutting board

Craft knife

**GLUE.** I use a good all round pva glue for paper and material or a glue stick. Separate brush for applying glue

Material or paper for covering your sketch book. We will be making a sketchbook approx. 28 x 16cm. You can also make additional sketchbooks of various sizes if you wish.

I cover my sketchbooks in colourful Japanese paper, but you can use any paper/or material to do this including tissue paper.
