## WATERCOLOUR REFRESH AND RECHARGE Tutor: Helen Cottle

### Materials list

- Plastic to cover your table, Coffee mug and name tag

### PAPER

- 2 X full sheets of Saunders or arches watercolour paper 300gms cold pressed (medium) or rough; pads are fine if working smaller

**BOARD** eg: Gator board, mdf or heavy cardboard to tape paper onto approx 60cm x 80cm or larger for full sheet

- 1 roll of masking tape
- white palette preferably with lid, any plastic palette is ok
- water fine mist spray bottle
- **masking fluid optional**
- AN OLD TOWEL IS HANDY
- WATER CONTAINERS
- TISSUES
- HAIR DRYER
- REFERENCE PHOTOS OR PICTURES (if you wish to work from your own photos)

### **WATERCOLOUR PAINT in your brand of choice.**

You can bring your normal palette of colours and adapt if needed OR
