Materials list

- Plastic to cover your table, Coffee mug and name tag
- Acrylic paints (Golden heavy body recommended especially for Permanent Green Light)
 - Hansa Yellow Light
 - Pthalo Blue (green shade)
 - Quinacridone Magenta (or Primary Magenta)
 - Cadmium Orange (or Pyrrole Orange)
 - Dioxazine Purple
 - Permanent Green Light
 - Titanium White
- Plastic palette knives
- Brushes: Neef or similar Short Flat Taklon 5mm, 10mm and 25mm (on the Seniors web site you will find them under “watercolour & gouache brushes” in synthetic/flat.)
- Easy clean palette (not wood) or tear-off palette book
- Sketch/note book
- 2 x 10 inch square canvas (universal primed)
- Sketching easel or table easel
- Water container
- Kitchen paper
- Due to time constraints, this is NOT a plein air workshop. Please bring a selection of landscape photographs to use for subject matter.
