SKETCHBOOKS AND JOURNALS

- Coffee mug, name tag and plastic to cover your table
- Wear protective, supportive and comfortable clothing and sturdy, non-slip footwear. The days are long, and we may be working outside on several different surfaces.
- Protect your hands with nitrile (my favourite), disposable or rubber gloves.

BRING some of the following from your stash, this could be a collection of interesting/favourite/recycled –

- **Drawing & Painting media:** Mark making materials, paint, ink, crayons etc in some of your favourite colours to work with for washes & stains
- **Papers:** 1 x sheet of 300gsm cotton rag paper, something lighter weight suitable for individual pages, signatures and folded structures and textured, wrapping, tissue, magazine, card, text & images, photocopies, envelopes.....
- **Fabrics:** Interesting textures, open weave, sheer, suitable for collage/coversmaybe something from your collection of pressed leaves/flowers, bones, shells, sticks, beads and threads.

Equipment that will be useful.

- Cutting mat
- Stencil knife, scalpel, or retractable blade “Stanley” type knife
- Rule, straight edge
- Bone folder, butter knife
- Awl
- 1” brush
- other brushes or mark making gear eg sticks, feathers, sponges etc
- matt medium, Glue stick
- Small pair of pliers
- Scrap paper
- Hand towel
- Notebook, pencil, pen, phone/camera
- Apron
