- Charcoal: willow charcoal fine, medium and thick, charcoal pencils in various softness, compressed charcoal.
- Black ink and spray bottle
- Eraser: kneadable and Faber-Castell
- Fixative: workable fixative
- Large drawing board and clips
- Scissors and cutting knife for collage
- Gloss medium to use as adhesive
- Sketchbook
- Extras: a range of wire brushes, scourers, course sandpaper and gouges for distressing the paper.
- Images that you might want to work from. Some will be provided.
