### **Materials list**

- **Name tag**
- **Coffee mug**
- Apron
- Gardening gloves
- Band aids
- Pens, pencils and sketchbook
- A fine sharpie
- Tweezers
- Scissors
- ruler
- Scalpels or box cutters
- Plastic contact sheet – used to cover school books
- Cutting mat
- Masking tape
- Double sided tape
- Glues (whatever you have, glue sticks, E-6000, araldite, pva)
- Craft paint
- Matte medium such as liquetex or mod podge
- A variety of brushes
- Contact
- Plastic containers for paint and glue
- A small bucket or rubbish bin
- Old toothbrushes and dishwasher brushes for cleaning tins
- Any pliers you may have, flat and round nose.
- A pair of side cutters
- Piercing saw
- A selection of sawblades, particularly 5/0 and 4/0
- half round hand files
- a selection of needle files
- tin snips
- Scribe
- Protractor and compass, plastic circle and other shape templates

### **Materials to work with**

- Be on the look out for biscuit tins and tobacco tins (tobacco tins are available in bulk lots quite cheaply on ebay)
- Bring books, magazines and ephemera for collage
- Small found objects to include in your assemblages – keep them small, there is a lot of power in miniature objects.
- Beads and other craft embellishments you might like to work with

If you have the following items and you have room in your car please bring them, otherwise, we can share:

- Rubber or plastic mallet
- Ball pein hammer
- Riveting hammer
- Bench vice
- Any brass and copper sheet you may have(<1mm thick)
- Any brass and copper wire and tube you may have
- Dremel or flexidrive or micromotor
- Chenier cutter
- Drill bits
- Emery sticks
- Small steel blocks for riveting
- Burnisher
- Round draw plate
- Eucalyptus oil

**Students will be required to wear covered shoes at all times.**
