## **Coil it Twine it Knot it**

### **Student requirement list**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug

### **Essential:**

- Scissors (not your sewing ones)
- Needle with a large eye
- An old towel
- Pen & paper to take notes
- Any strings, cords, etc you want to try stitching with, but they must be strong, like raffia or linen threads (I will have waxed linen for sale by the spool or some by the metre)

### **Optional:**

- Something to work around, like a large abalone shell, nice rock, bit of wood, sea glass, etc
- Any interesting fibres, leaves, wire, etc you want to try. For coiling the length doesn't really matter. You can slip in short little bits of interesting texture or colour if you want.
- An interesting flat button or disc for the centre of your coiling if you like (or you can just start the centre with the fibres you will be using)
- Embellishments: feathers, interesting bits & pieces of fibres, fabric, wool, roots branches, shells, beads with reasonable holes, etc
- Curved needle with a large eye
- Spray bottle to dampen fibres if necessary
