MULTI LAYERED LINOCUTS AND REPEATS

Materials list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Old Clothes or protective apron
- A packet baby wipes
- Rubber/Vinyl gloves (the ones for food prep are fine) if you are worried about getting printing ink on your hands
- Some plastic plates (BBQ ones- or the trays on which meat comes)
- Some plastic spoons
- Fabric without obvious designs or plains, hand dyed fabric is very suitable. Iron the fabric flat and bring at least 10 pieces. About 3 – 4 mt in total. Also bring some pieces of white or ecru fabric. Darker colours are difficult to print on but do bring one or two. Bring some larger pieces of fabric for the repeat printing.
- Some newspapers
- A foam roller 3-4 inches wide (can be gotten in a hardware shop such as Bunnings- the Uni-Pro 85 mm are good to use) The foam needs to be dense
- Some scrap cloths or a few kitchen wipes.
- An Artists paint brush with firm bristle if you have it.
- Masking tape
- Lino cutting tools if you have them
- Your ideas book/journal. Think of a theme or two that you might like to work with - ones that have different shapes and shapes of different scale- and also shapes that have good lines.
- Pencils and drawing paper
- Sharpie permanent texta- fine and medium.
- If you would like to stitch on your piece you can do so by hand or machine in which case bring your sewing needs, such as embroidery threads and needles, some wadding (lightweight)or cotton flannel and some backing fabric.
- **Material fee:** \$30 to be paid in cash on the first day of the workshop. If you really want to print a large amount there may be an additional fee.
