Student requirement list

- Name tag

- Plastic to cover your 2 work tables

- 250 grams extra fine merino roving, 19 micron or less, in main colour for project.
- 100 grams extra fine merino roving, 19 micron or less, in white.
- 5.0 metres silk habotai/paj/ponge silk (4.5 -5 momme) if the fabric is 114cm wide, in main colour for project.
- 2.5 metres silk habotai/paj/ponge silk (4.5 -5 momme) in white.

- Bubblewrap: 2 pieces, each 122cm x 240cm
- Note: the two items above can be replaced by your usual felting and wetting out work surface and covering material, in the above sizes.
- Measuring tape
- Calculator
- Drawing Book, notepad
- Pen/pencil
- Small bucket/container for water
- Ball Brause, or other tool for wetting out wool
- Scissors, very sharp
- Old towels (2-3)
- Pool Noodle, Pipe or Dowel
- Table risers for 2 tables
- Sewing thread in the main project colour

- Materials kit. This will be provided by Fiona for each student which includes ramie fibre, sumi-e ink, brushes, embellishment materials, resist materials, tape and soap. **The fee for these kits is \$40.00.** Paid on the first day of the workshop in cash.
