PAINTED FABRIC

Materials list

- **Name tag**
- **Coffee mug**
- **Plastic to cover you work-table**
- 1 dozen silk scarves a mixture of paj or habutai (6 to 8 mm, weight of silk) medium size 28 x 160, large 42 x 180, Chiffon or gauze 45 x 180. Heavier crepe de chine if preferred
- 2 metres lightweight - paj or habutai (6 to 8 mm)
- Simple pattern for 3 garments and the amount of yardage required, choose a heavier silk such as crepe de chine, fuji, duppion, satin backed crepe. Not raw silk.
- Coloured fabric marker that washes out
- 3 Brushes, mixture of medium to large as for watercolor painting or small bristle paint brushes from hardware shop
- Tube of gutta suitable for silk-painting, available online or Spotlight
- 20 small jars with lid, plastic or glass
- Small saucepan for melting wax
- Tjanting for wax if you have one
- 3 small plastic trays or take away containers
- Piece of thick foam to cut shapes for printing
- 2 yoghurt containers for water
- Scissors, tape measure, pins etc
- Shoe box

Please wear work clothes, covered shoes & apron.
