THE FABULOUS MELON BASKET!

Material list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Scissors sharp - but not your best pair!
- Craft or sharp knife
- An awl or small Philips-head screwdriver
- Chopstick or skewer
- Secateurs
- Apron or protective cloth
- An old sheet or large towel (to dampen and wrap/mellow natural fibre)
- Large garbage bag or two
- Bucket

Fabulous Melon Basket

Remove seed heads if travelling from out of the state. Pull or cut low down and aim for length and strength. Always seek permission if entering private land. Keep an eye out on green waste collection days. Best if materials are dry, bundled and named.

- Leaf materials includes watsonia, crocosmia, iris leaf various types, day lily, red-hot poker, cumbungi, tall spike rush, river club rush. New Zealand Flax (best picked at last minute) cordyline both green and dry.
- Vines and creepers include jasmine, hop, clematis, grape, periwinkle, wisteria...
- Native leaf material: dianella, diplarena, poa, lomandra, kangaroo grass, juncus,
- Strips of fabric dyed or textured, beach rope, cords; plus anything else you would like to try...
- First year prunings of willow, fruit trees vegetation (must be pliable and supple)
- Handle material includes willow, hazel, grape create a ring and tie off, let dry or use a solid stick or piece of wood

If it looks useful, put it in your stash you can't go home to get it!
