Materials list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your work table
- Bubble wrap 2.8-3m long ,1.2m wide
- Thin plastic sheeting (Painters drop sheet, see through)
- Resist material 2m (Thin foam floor underlay).
- Bar of soap,
- Ball Brause,
- Container 2litre
- 500g coloured wool sliver 19 micron (could be variegated) This is plenty, but you may want more of one colour. This is enough for one vest.
- Coloured silk fabric, tissue silk, 5metres. Have colours that will contrast and harmonise with your fibre colour.
- Paj/pongee silk 2m (These can be in smaller pieces and in colourways) It is more than you will need but you will want choice. We will be using this for the some outside and facings. You can also just use the tissue silk instead.
- Small bag of silk and other fibres to add in to work. (optional)
- 3 old towels
- Paper and pencil, marker, camera.
- Sharp scissors
- Pair of old stockings to tie roll.
- Old sheet or fabric 1m x 1m.
- Normal thread, embroidery thread, needle/pins
- Tape measure
- Calculator
- Interesting button or closure.
- 10 x 10 cm square on paper.
- Table risers for 2 tables
