Student requirement list

- Sewing machine, (extension cord and power board)
- Thread to match you project
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter 45mm
- Rotary cutter 18mm*
- Gridded ruler (suggested size 6" x 23" or similar)
- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Un-picker
- Thread-snips
- Pen and graph paper for designing your quilt
- 1/4" ruler*
- Paper scissors
- Small or flat headed pins
- Pencil and eraser
- Fabric- a minimum of 0.5 mt (wof) of four or more different colours of quilting cotton and 2 mt (wof) of the same of background fabric. More fabric needed for any project larger than a throw sized quilt.
- Design board*: could be a piece of wadding/batting that can be hung up. You can easily make your own from an old real estate agent's sign – I have asked at the local agents as they are usual just thrown out!, 4 make a great size design wall and then cover it with pallen of flannelette, easy to pull apart to store and travel with)
- You will have the opportunity to purchases *Pappersaxsten* Drunkard's Path templates at very reduced rate (the Complete DP Set \$83 (very cheap!!))
