Student requirement list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Any round rope or string material that has a bit of stiffness such as paper cord, parachute cord, coaxial cable wire (stripped of plastic outer casing), plastic coated wire (recycled preferred).
(rolls of plastic-coated wire by the roll are available at Jaycar or similar stores)
Note: If you wish to make a metre wide piece you will need at least 200-250 metres of material. If you wish to make smaller sample pieces with different weft twining techniques, you will need around 100 metres. If you are using two or more colours then you will need more of one colour for your spokes. Remember: it's always better to have a little more material than not enough.

Work can also be mounted on to a board for displaying.
