## **WEAVING WORDS**

### **Student requirement list**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug

### **EQUIPMENT**

- Some of your favorite tools: folded or Cola pens, Parallel and or automatic pens, Copperplate, Speedball B, any special effect nibs like the Mitchell/ Rexel scroll or music nibs
- Several round brushes for painting and writing. Numbers between 2 & 6. Pentel brush
- Dropper or pippetes, airliners applicator or syringe with needle
- Watercolour or gouache in tubes or pans of colours of the textiles, no more than 6 colours plus white and walnut ink
- 2 water containers, for pale and dark colours
- Palette to prepare colours and a pipette to collect them
- 2 containers with lids to store prepared colours
- Any type of device to prevent tools and brushes from rolling all over the place
- Pencil eraser
- Paper tape UHU glue stick, double sided tape
- Coloured pencils – if water soluble – better
- Portable light (extension cord and power board) If you don't have one you could bring a portable easel with a alight underneath to be about to trace in a comfortable way would work.
- Paper towel or rags

### **PAPER**

- Some sheets of your favorite layout paper
- Twenty sheets of paper – A4. You could either purchase a block, or have your pages cut in advance form an Arches Text Woven sheet form a sheet of 22" x 30" you get 8 pages of 8" x 11". If you consider the light weight watercolour paper with a smooth surface, light paper is anything less than 300 gsm

## MISCELLANEOUS OR MATERIALS THAT WE MAY USE

- Fine liners like Micron Edding, Drawliner or anything similar
- Embroider needle and thread
- Fusible bond, Heat & Bond
- Extra nibs to stick, sew or glue to your work

Finally by the end of the workshop I will be asking you to colour copy on a good quality paper, maybe Arches Text Wove paper, some steps of your work to weave them together. You will need

- A soft A4 size cardboard, 2 or 3 mm thick, glue stick, straight edge metal ruler and sharp cutter. A 28.5 cm zipper matching your colour palette and matching sewing thread.
