## **STITCH DRAW ON FABRIC**

### **Student requirement list**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Sewing machine (extension cord and power board)
- Black thread
- any other coloured threads you like (a graduated grey is nice)
- Embroidery hoop (about 8inch diameter)
- Free machine embroidery foot for your sewing machine
- Tissue paper
- Print outs of your own photographs (A4 black and white) can be any images that interest you. (people, family, etc.)
- Pencils, paper, small sketchbook
- White cotton sheeting type fabric. (1m)
- Medium weight calico (1m)
- Transparent cloth such as polyester veil or silk organza. (50cm)
- Thicker canvas weight fabric (50cm)
- Any other fabrics you have in your stash you would like to experiment with! Such as netting, or leather, or fake fur, etc...
- A gelli plate (small one)
- A printing roller.
- Acrylic paints
- Wet wipes
- Selection of printed coloured fabric scraps
- Bondaweb (50cms)
- Iron and something to iron on.
- Camera (or use your phone) and the USB connector to connect to a laptop.
- If you have a lightbox bring it, if not don't worry.
