- **Drawing pencils:** HB, 2B, Holbein sandpaper block, kneadable rubber
- **Watercolour brushes:** size 6, 8, medium size mop, and 2" Hake
- **Colour palette:** the primaries, also,
 - Cerulean Blue,
 - Ultramarine Blue,
 - Burnt Sienna,
 - Raw Sienna,
 - Burnt Umber,
 - Hookers Green,
 - Vandyke Brown,
 - Yellow Ochre,
 - Buff Titanium,
 - Lavender,
 - Quinacridone Gold,
 - Viridian,
 - Lavender, (plus your personal favourites)
- Stanley knife
- Watercolour palette
- water jar – just the normal stuff for painting that you use at present.
