- Easy clean palette (not wood) or tear-off palette book
- Sketchbook with watercolour paper or canvas pages
- Masking tape
- 2 x 10 or 12 inch square canvas and 1 x 24 inch square canvas (universal primed) Size is less important than that they are square.
- Sketching easel or table easel
- Water container
- Kitchen paper
