# **MIXED MEDIA LANDSCAPES ON PAPER**

### **PLEASE BRING**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

### **MATERIAL LIST**

- 6-8 large sheets of smooth heavyweight paper (approx. 300gsm). Choose something you won't be intimidated to use. Snowdon cartridge is a good low-cost option. Hot-press watercolour paper is also suitable, but more expensive.
- Sketchbook for information gathering and experiments.
- Water soluble pencil or chalk in a dark colour, such as an Inktense block, Artgraf or Wolff's carbon pencil, if you already have one. If you don't, I will have them available for you to try.
- Black acrylic ink. Art Spectrum, Liquitex or Atelier drawing ink are all suitable. Some will be available in class for student use.
- Acrylic paint. Good choices are red iron oxide or burnt sienna, cadmium red, cadmium yellow or hansa yellow medium, Australian sienna, ultramarine blue, black and titanium white, but feel free to bring what you have. Mixing colours is part of the fun.
- Brushes. A small selection of brushes of different sizes, flat and round. It is useful to have a mixture of soft and stiff brushes. Include one cheap brush to use for glueing.
- A small selection of coloured pencils, oil pastels and/or wax crayons. Don't buy anything special, just bring what you have. There will be supplies for you to try if you don't already have these items in your studio
- Palette/palette paper
- Spray bottle
- Old credit card
- Painting rags, paper towels or wet wipes
- Water pots (yoghurt pots or similar)
- Bring and apron and/or wear old clothes

## Materials fee: \$20

I will provide paper for collage experiments, adhesives, wax crayons, oil sticks, gels and mediums and a variety of different inks for you to use during the workshop.
