Every person has individual creative paths and understandings. My workshop will scaffold on prior knowledge and creative wants. You will look at proportions, composition, scale, foreshortening, mark making and colour. Each student will be encouraged to explore mediums and styles, working with however it is they currently create.

Bring along images of people you wish to create portraits of. Ideally these should be on an iPad or phone.

MATERIAL LIST

- Acrylic paint (house paints) red, yellow, blue, black and white. Small sample pots
- Cardboard assorted sizes one at least 150 cm by 100 cm (approx) min 8 pieces pending on individual output. If prolific bring more.
- Paint brushes sizes varied from small, size 2 to 2-inch brush.
- pot for water
- easel
- if students prefer canvas absolutely ok.
- iPad or phone to take photos
- If students wish to work in other mediums, please feel free to bring them along.

Model fee \$50 to be paid in cash on the first day of the workshop.
