MATERIAL LIST

- A3 acrylic paper pad (roughly 280gsm),
- A5 sketch pad,
- 3 x 66 x 66cm canvases **OR** 3 x 70cm x 50cm **OR** a mix of the two sizes,
- a variety of brushes for painting small to medium-large works,
- acrylic paints,
- oil stick or two,
- watercolour pencils (montmarte 36 piece is good beginners brand),
- water soluble graphite,
- mixing palette (foil tray or large plastic plate from woolies/coles),
- water dish,
- paint rags,
- glazing medium (for extending the paint),
- black ball point ink pen,
- scissors and glue (or matte gel which is a glue and collage medium)

*Please supply your own easel if required. I tend to work flat on the table or floor.
