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## **STITCH A BOWL**

**TUTOR: KATHRYN HARMER FOX**

### **PLEASE BRING**

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle

### **EQUIPMENT NEEDED**

- Domestic sewing machine (must be able to disengage the feed dogs)
- Darning/embroidery foot, universal foot
- Steel-sprung embroidery ring (about 21,5cm)
- Extension table
- Jeans/denim needles plus others
- Sharp scissors
- Usual sewing paraphernalia; pins, tape measure, etc
- Black, fine-liner, felt-tipped pen (with which to do tracing)

### **MATERIALS NEEDED**

- About 1 m of thin, light-weight, white cotton (this will be captured within the embroidery ring and will form the base of the image).
- About 2 m of soft, floppy, natural fibre fabric in the colour, pattern of your choice (it must tear easily along the grain as this will be used to create the ragged cord for your bowl).
- An assortment of scraps of fabric from which to create your image. Investigate both the right side and the wrong side. Look at patterned and sheer fabrics. You will be using tiny pieces so, in this instance, size does not matter.
- A collection of various sewing threads, colours relative to your image. I very seldom use either embroidery or variegated threads; the first shouts very loudly but lacks innate strength and the second is too dictatorial.
