- Something to draw with eg Pigma Micron PN (permanent) in brown or black,
- Artline 200 fineliner (water-soluble) black, 2B mechanical pencil, water-soluble
- coloured pencils, biros, fountain pens etc
- Other materials to bring if you have them: watercolour brushes, best quality
- watercolour tube paints or a watercolour travel kit... eg warm and cool of each
- primary Blue, Yellow, Red plus Sap Green, Naples Yellow (Daniel Smith), Paynes
- Grey
- Hat, coat, etc for working outside and portable chair if you want
