SEASCAPES IN ACRYLIC Tutor: Hannah Blackmore

Materials list

- Plastic to cover your table, Coffee mug and name tag
- 1 x A4 pad of canvas paper.
- 2 x HB pencils + eraser + sharpener.
- 4 stretched canvases - ideally around 40cm x 50cm (or around that size, whatever is practical to bring).
- 5 x brushes - assorted sizes from small to up to 2cm.
- 1 x small palette knife (optional).
- Kitchen roll (doesn't need to be a whole roll).
- 10 x plastic picnic plates to use as palettes (dinner plate size).
- Plastic cup or water holder.
- Bubble wrap (to transport your work home safely).

2 x Titanium White

1 x Ultramarine Blue

1 x Phthalo Blue

1 x Burnt Umber

1 x Raw Umber

1 x Burnt Sienna

1 x Raw Sienna

Recommend Mont Marte Dimension Acrylics or Atelier Interactive, but any student or professional acrylics are fine.
