Materials list

- Plastic to cover your table, Coffee mug and name tag

PAPER

- 4 X full sheets of Saunders or arches watercolour paper 300gms cold pressed (medium) or rough; pads are fine if working smaller

BOARD eg: Gator board, mdf or heavy cardboard to tape paper onto approx 60cm x 80cm or larger for full sheet

- 1 roll of masking tape
- white palette preferably with lid, any plastic palette is ok
- water fine mist spray bottle
- **masking fluid optional**
- AN OLD TOWEL IS HANDY
- WATER CONTAINERS
- TISSUES
- HAIR DRYER
- REFERENCE PHOTOS OR PICTURES (if you wish to work from your own photos)

WATERCOLOUR PAINT in your brand of choice.

You can bring your normal palette of colours and adapt if needed OR
