- Your usual watercolours and palette

Paper: 2 full sheet cold pressed & 1 full rough: 300 GSM Baohong, Arches, Saunders Waterford or Fabriano ([I use Baohong](#))

- A board big enough to accommodate the size of half sheet.
- Beige coloured masking tape not coloured ½ inch or narrower to adhere paper to board
- 1 Large round brush with a good point size 12, 1" flat brush, 1 linear brush,
- Tissues, Old towel or washer, Sponge.
- 2 Water containers
- iPad or Notebook for photo reference Easier for viewing and enlarging for detail when needed. Or printing reference to bring. A stand for iPad to lean on. Images of Landscape, Seascape. Animals in the Landscape, Photos of people walking. I can airdrop images if you have an iPad.
- Something to lean painting on at 45 degrees. Your tissue box is a good size
- A cloth for the table

* Students work at a 45degree angle leaning board against a tissue box. If there is no sink and tap then we would need an empty bucket to collect dirty water and a bucket filled with water for students to scoop out fresh water.
