## Material list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your work table
- 5 metres x 4-5 momme pongee/paj silk in your desired colour- this will be the main colour of your garment. 115 cm is ideal.
- 3 metres x 5 momme pongee/paj in white. 90cm wide is ideal but wider is fine.
- 200 grams total, extra fine merino roving, 19 micron or less, in two main colours for project. (Note: 100 grams in each colour, for a total of 200 grams) Select two colours that you love! These will be similar to your main silk colour above. Best results are achieved with bold, bright and/or darker colours. Pale colours are not recommended as they flatten the colours of the dyed and painted silk (unless you are bringing a pale/pastel dyed silk)
- 150 grams extra fine merino roving, 19 micron or less, in charcoal grey. A deep grey, but not black.
- Measuring tape
- Calculator
- Scissors very sharp
- Drawing book/ notepad
- Pen/pencil
- Sewing Needles
- Thread in main wool colour
- 2 towels Pool noodle and/or pvc pipe/wooden dowel for rolling (should be about 120cm long) Ball brause or other container/tool for wetting out your felt.
- Table risers

The following supplies will be provided by Fiona for use by each student during the workshop: inks, fabric paints, brushes, silk stretching frames, hooks, felting work surface (grip mat + thin plastic sheeting), resist materials, tape, soap, paper Supplies Fee: \$40.00 to be paid in cash on the first day of the workshop.
